Surgery prices are estimates only and include a prior full physical examination, the surgery procedure, monitored aftercare and suture removal if necessary. Oral antibiotics and/or pain medicine are at an additional cost. External sutures are rarely used but if present are generally removed 10 days following surgery.

We recommend a pre-anesthetic blood screen for all animals in for surgery. This gives us a good idea of your pet's general health by testing kidney and liver function as well as blood glucose, and red and white blood cell levels. These parameters provide a baseline for your pet's health and will alert us to potential problems. The pre-anesthetic screen is offered for an additional fee.

We require that appointments be made and honored in order to insure we have time to care for you as well as our other patients without being overly rushed.
